Dear Warrensburg Tiger Parents/Guardians:

I trust this finds you and your family well during this “interesting” time we are all experiencing. Given all the uncertainty the rest of this year holds, it’s hard to imagine we need to start planning for next school year. Yes, it is time to enroll in classes for the 2020-21 school year. Normally, this would have been completed during our Academy classes during the last few weeks, but this year will be a bit of a change. Luckily, our process will not have to change much, but unfortunately, we will not have the true face to face time with our students.

Your WHS student(s) will still utilize their Academy teachers during the process for guidance, and as always, the WHS Counselors are available for any questions. The documents needed are included in the link provided below, but we will also offer a drive through distribution of the 2020-21 Course Description Guide on April 16 (Thursday) from 11:00am-1:00pm at the main entrance of WHS. Our counselors and administrators will be there to provide a hard copy to those wanting one. Again, we thank you for your patience during this process and hope planning for next year will provide some excitement (and sense of normalcy) for our students.

Starting today (4/13), students can log in to their PowerSchool account and click on the link on the left titled ‘Course Registration’. From there they can select their preferred courses for next school year (2020-2021). In theory, only classes they are able to take should be available for them to select; however, as we know, technology isn’t always perfect.

The WHS Enrollment Information link is below, which will direct you to the documents that will assist in the course selection process. We ask that you spend time reviewing these materials with your student and help them carefully select their classes for the next school year.

Typically we have students circle their requests on the appropriate form, have a parent sign it, and return it to their Academy teacher. Of course, this year we will be doing things a bit different.

- 1) Students need to log in to their PowerSchool account, and use the appropriate Course Selection Sheet to pick their classes for next year.
- 2) Make sure once your student has selected classes, they scroll to the bottom of the screen and click ‘submit’.
- 3) Have them take a picture of the screen that lists their course selections and email that to their Academy teacher.
